Jordan National Metrology Institute

The Jordan National Metrology Institute (JNMI) was established in 2006 according to the signed authorization agreement between the Jordan Standards and Metrology Organization (JSMO) and the Royal Scientific Society (RSS) to be the national metrology institute of Jordan.

Our institute is comprised of two divisions: the Electrical Metrology division; and the Physical and Mechanical Metrology division; as well as 14 calibration and measuring laboratories disseminated between the national and the secondary levels. We maintain the national measurement standards in the fields of electrical, physical, mechanical and medical metrology and assure their traceability to international standards.

Our laboratories are accredited according to ISO/IEC 17025 by the Jordan Accreditation System (JAS), which is internationally recognised.

What we do:

- Maintain the national measurement standards
- Ensure the traceability of national measurement standards to international standards
- Check for, study and implement any updates related to the international system (SI) of units
- Perform research in the field of Metrology
- Participate in inter-laboratory comparison programs on local and international levels
- Maintain the national measurement standard database

We provide:

- Locally and internationally accredited measuring and calibration
- Technical consultancy
- Capacity building, training courses, seminars and workshops

Facts about our centre:

- We issue more than 7000 calibration certificates annually
- Our calibration laboratories were the first in the Middle East to be internationally accredited in 1998 from the German Accreditation Body (DAkkS)
